

Feeling left out

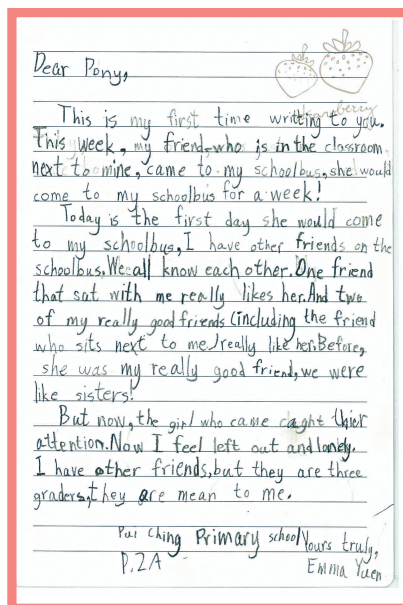
Dear Pony,

But now, this girl has caught their attention, and I feel left out and lonely.

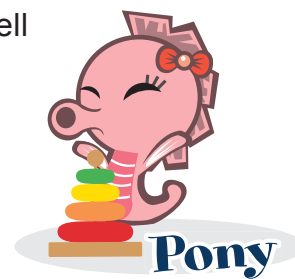

If this situation keeps going, tell them how you feel – they will understand and try to include you. I hope you can all stay friends!

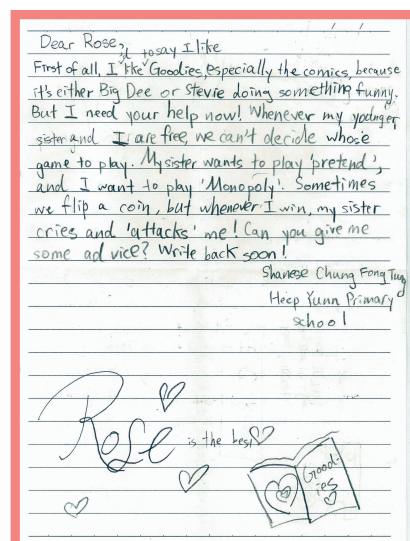


Problems with sisters
